Dear Members & Friends of First United Church,

The call of a new minister is a critical event in the life of a congregation. As our active congregation becomes smaller, our volunteer base and donations of time and money continues to shrink as well. Fewer young families and people are attending our church. Without the financial support of the Centre Street Thrift store, and without more members, our sustainability as a church is at risk. It is now more important than ever to discern your gifts and the ways in which you would like to help your community of faith. How do you envision the life of Hanna First United Church in the future, and the needs for new ministry personnel in a church that has changed significantly as culture and community life varies dramatically from "the way things used to be"?
